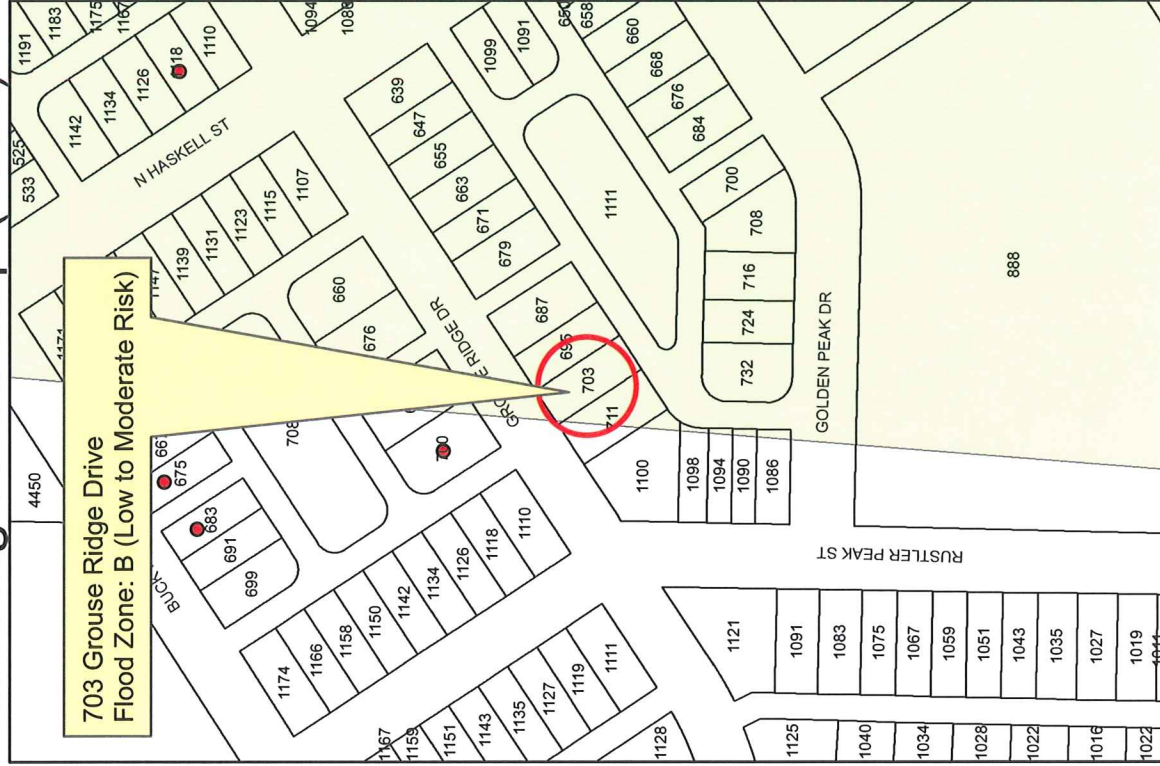

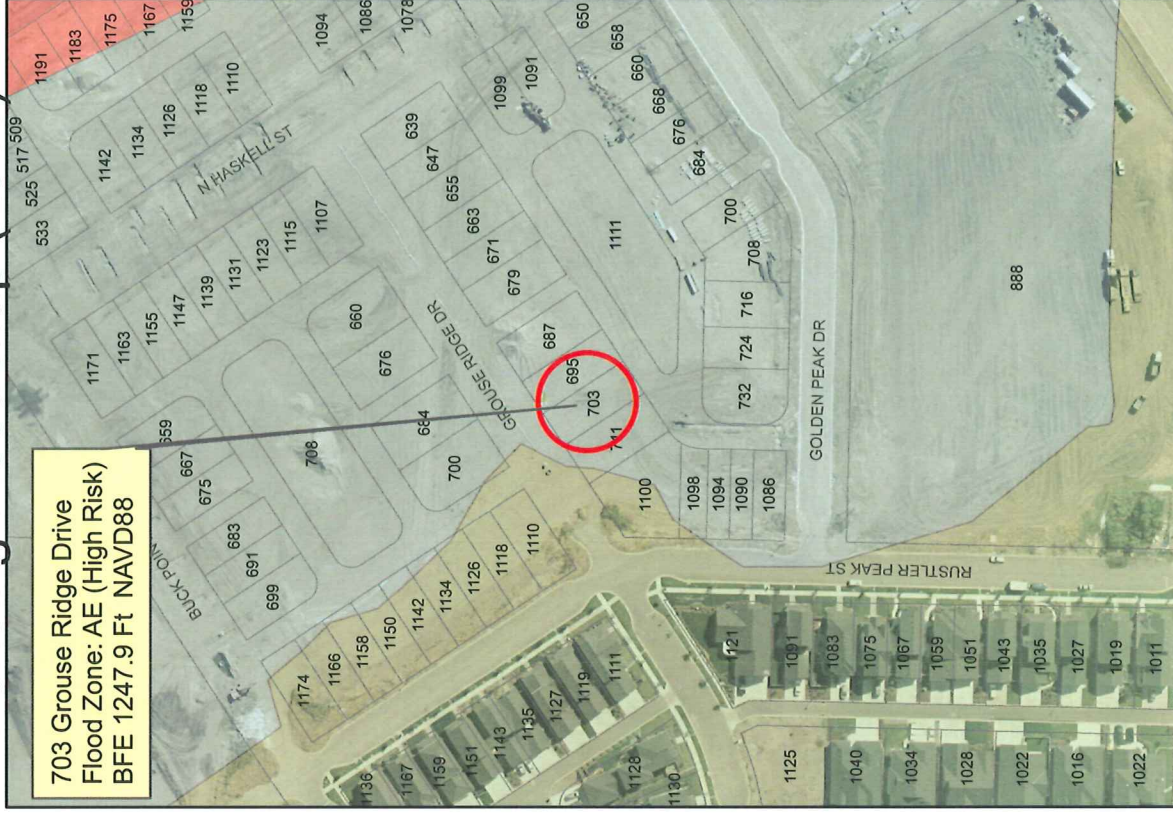
## Existing Flood Map (1982)
